

GRANT APPROVAL PROCESS

SOME KEY POINTS:

- Organisations can only submit one application at a time.
- If an application is unsuccessful, you cannot reapply for a grant for 12 months, from the date of your initial application.



YES

MAY make grants for:

- Amateur golf development
- Historic Preservation of the Town of St Andrews
- The University of St. Andrews



NO

Grants NOT provided for:

- Statutory bodies or profit-making organisations
- Organisations working purely with elite sport or promoting sporting talent
- Individuals for their sole benefit
- Major infrastructural projects or large capital grants
- Disaster or emergency humanitarian relief projects



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FORM

All applicants must complete an Expression of Interest Form **for which the deadline is 1st July.**



ACCEPTED

The project is awarded a grant on the basis of the Expression of Interest Form.



DECLINED

The project is declined a grant on the basis of the Expression of Interest Form.



APPLICATION FORM

The applicant is asked to complete an Application Form, for which the deadline is **September 1**, for consideration by the Trustees at their annual meeting, at which point a grant may or may not be awarded.



ACCEPTED

Grant approved



DECLINED

Grant application declined
